A well-maintained shed will look better, last longer, and save you money over time. These simple tips help protect your shed in every season — whether it's brand new or years old.

1. Regular Cleaning

Sweep out debris and dirt regularly from floors, corners, and shelving. For the exterior, use a mild detergent or wood-safe cleaner to clean siding, trim, and doors.




2. Inspect for Damage

Look for:

- Loose or missing shingles
- Cracks in the siding
- Issues with trim, windows, or doors
- Signs of shifting or settling in the foundation

Catch small issues early to avoid major repairs.



3. Seasonal Maintenance

Spring / Summer:

- Clear leaves and buildup from ridge or gable vents
- Inspect roof for weather-related damage
- Clean gutters (if installed)

Fall / Winter:

- Watch for water pooling around the shed base
- Check joists and floor for moisture damage or instability
- Inspect insulation (if installed)

4. Paint and Seal for Protection

Use high-quality exterior paint or sealer to protect siding and trim. Repaint every few years depending on sun, rain, and exposure levels.
